New Business:

- Chuckar Challenge: Brian is not purchasing Major Ave Hunt club. Scott Scheidt talked to Jerry at Major Ave. If we have the event out there we will need to purchase the birds from him at \$14 each. Raise the cost for Singles Run \$5, Doubles Run \$10. Dave Sell will go and talk to Jerry to find out more information.
- Al Hahn talked with GPL for Fundraiser. Will be the 2nd Sunday of August along with the Eggravanska. Looking at doing 3 raffles, GPL will pay for 50% and we cover 50%. 3-D archery,. They are starting their own Sponsorship. Cost is \$500 and you receive a Jacket and your name on a plaque, also have a membership of \$200 that includes a Jacket but no plaque. Their Insurance would cover everything but we would have to the gambling permit for the day if we do the raffles. McLeod Fish and Wildlife will be having a game at their Banquet that part of the funds from the Game will be going to help with these expenses as well. Don Sauter will get in touch with someone who will donate the Eye and Ear Protection for the Shooting League. Motion made by Kerby Kroells that Corporate pay \$500 to the schools for the Sporting Clays and up to each chapter if they wish to do more. Amendum to stick with Schools in McLeod and Sibley County. Motion made by Al Hahn, 2nd by Bob Reid. Approved by all. Patches for the Chapters, This expense should be paid by the Corporate. Motion made by Dean Reid to have the money coming out of corporate for the patches. 2nd by Ryan Wroge. Approved by all.
